### **Independence Skills**

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The student will demonstrate the appropriate independent navigation skills ( public transportation, driving, reading a map or GPS, know local landmarks). The student will demonstrate how to ask for help. Student will also demonstrate restaurant ordering and shopping skills. Student will demonstrate how to make and keep appointments.
