We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2021-2022 educational progress for the Charlevoix Montessori Academy for the Arts. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and some requirements of state laws. Our staff is available to help you understand this information. These reports contain the following information:

For the 2021-2022 school year, schools were identified using definitions and labels as required in Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67%. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school was not identified as a reward, a focus, or a priority school.

Charlevoix Montessori Academy for the Arts faces challenges in having a high population of high need students, limited staff, and economic restraints. Due to these challenges, Charlevoix Montessori Academy for the Arts has put structures in place to accommodate the needs of individual students while into consideration the staff and resources to implement these structures.

Continuous improvement is Charlevoix Montessori Academy for the Art's goal and through the partnership with families at the school and community resources we will reach the goals of each student enrolled.

2. Our school improvement plan includes goals for increasing the test scores in Reading, Math, Writing, and Science. In addition, our school improvement plan has goals for improving student behavior and community/ parent engagement. In 2022-2023, all staff will participate in professional development designed to develop and improve our school improvement plan.

4. The following information was gathered from the 2021-2022 data:

- Student Academic Growth for grades 1-3 improved from 25.2% to 51.3%.
- SAT total score decreased from 940 to 873.3.
- For the 2021-2022 school year, there was 100% graduation rate.

5. 75 percent of parents participated in our fall and spring parent teacher conferences.

6. For High School students at Charlevoix Montessori Academy for the Arts:

- a. There was one student that was dual enrolled.
- b. There was no student taking AP classes.
- c. There was one student enrolled in college equivalent courses.
- d. There was one student to receive college credits for the classes.
