Reconfirm instructional delivery method:
Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:
Elementary (Grades K - 5): Hybrid and online instruction by Zoom, Seesaw, and Google Classroom.
Middle School (Grades 6 - 8): Hybrid and online instruction by Zoom, and Google Classroom.
High School (Grades 9 - 12): Hybrid and online instruction by Zoom, and Google Classroom.
Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:
High-level instruction is given in-person and online.
